We are working on scheduling the charter to St George for this weekend. My Materials Coordinator is working on arranging the off loading in St George, and we will have a definitive schedule later today or tomorrow.

Question: Nanwalek does not have a diesel plant. The Utility is Homer Electric, and the standby diesel plant that feeds Nanwalek is in Port Graham. There is also a standby diesel plant in Seldovia.

Seldovia, Port Graham, and Nanwalek all are fed from the railbelt through an intertie from Homer. Seldovia and Port Graham are not on the inventory list, but Nanwalek is.

Please advise as to whether you'd like us to go to Nanwalek, or to Seldovia or Port Graham.
