The Bid documents for the above project are amended as follows (All other terms and conditions remain unchanged):

GENERAL – QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

- 1) **Q:** The building of the module, in-house, does not require Davis-Bacon prevailing wages. Therefore is AEA waiving the Certified Payroll requirements as noted on page 00 70 00-28; section 7.14.1?

A: If a contractor’s construction of the module is not at the ‘site of the work’ (Reference 29 CFR 5.2(1)), Davis-Bacon wages and Certified Payroll are not required.

- 2) **Q:** I would then believe that section 7.14.2 and 7.14.3 of page 00 70 0-29 would also be waived?

A: Section 7.14.2 and 7.14.3 are only applicable to Add-Alt One which requires Davis-Bacon wages since services will be performed at the “site of work”.
