If, by virtue of this addendum it is desired to modify a bid already submitted, such modification may be made by email or telefacsimile provided such an email or telefacsimile makes reference to this addendum and is received prior to the opening hour and date specified above.

The Bid documents for the above project are amended as follows (All other terms and conditions remain unchanged):

CONTRACT PROVISIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

- 1) A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting is scheduled for **April 24, 2020, 10:30 am. Do to the COVID-19 the pre-bid meeting will be conducted telephonically.** Potential bidders may attend telephonically by calling **1-888-585-9008**, when prompted enter **508-917-314#**. Please note the call-in is limited to participants so if more than one person from companies are attending telephonically, we respectfully request you call in from a conference room speaker phone and have all people together. If calling in, please be respectful of other callers and call from a phone that can be muted so as to cancel out background noise and the possibility of feedback. This is not a mandatory meeting, and there will not be a scheduled site visit prior to the bid opening.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERES

- 1) **Question: I was told another retrofit tank is added to this ITB.**

1. **Answer:** Yes a retrofit tank for Tatitlek. Retrofit one (1) owner-provided, 11,600-gallon, double wall, dual product, UL-2085 protected dispensing tank to add duel product retail fuel dispensing

with card reader. Owner provided tank is FOB the AEA Warehouse in Anchorage, AK. Work required in 'Section 01 11 13 Summary of Work'.

2) Question: What do you mean by "Retrofit"?

Answer: Modify. The 5,000 gallon tank is in the photo that was included with the solicitation documents. It was built to UL-2085 standards per the specifications. It is complete, less the appurtenances. It is in like new condition with the exception of minimal paint scuffing that occurred during transportation.

3) Question: The equipment for the 3,000 gallon tank, are you supplying that?

Answer: No. That will be the contractor's responsibility.

4) Question: What should bidders do if they determine that their suppliers will not be able to deliver materials in time to meet project deadlines due to Covid-19?

Answer: Bidders shall alert AEA prior to the bid opening date if they encounter difficulties securing materials for the project. AEA will evaluate the situation and respond accordingly.

5) Question: What if travel restrictions due to Covid 19 interfere with the project schedule?

Answer: For the purpose of developing bids, Bidders shall assume that the COVID-19 travel restrictions currently in place will be lifted prior to beginning on site construction activities. Bidders are encouraged to review Supplemental Conditions SC-11.5 Extension Due to Delays for additional information.
