ADDENDUMS 4 & 5

TO ALL POTENTIAL OFFERORS:

Below is a summary of the Addendums 1-3 posted to RFP 22019. This advisory also adds Addendums 4 and 5 respectively below. All potential offerors are advised to review the Addendums below.

Acknowledgement of these addendums is required on the Proposal Form. Failure to do so may subject the offeror to disqualification.

Addendum 1: Changed Part C of the RFP.

Addendum 2: Changed Statement of Service (SOS) of the RFP.

Addendum 3: Added the AIDEA Sample Contract

Addendum 4: **(NEW)**

In Appendix D (Indemnification and Insurance), page 2 of 2, item D3.4 is checked indicating that Professional Liability Insurance is NOT required. This conflicts with Item 11 of Part A of the RFP which indicates that Professional Liability Insurance IS required. The scope for this RFP includes road and bridge (structural) engineering.

CLARIFICATION/CHANGE: Professional Liability Insurance IS REQUIRED.

Addendum 5: **(NEW)**

Where as a potential conflict exists between Criterion 6 (Labor Billing Rates) of Part C of the RFP and item 9 of Part A, which states *"Price cannot be an Evaluation Criterion in accordance with PL-92.582 Brooks Act for services that must be performed only by Architects, Engineers or Land Surveyors (A/E or LS) licensed in the State of Alaska..."*.

CLARIFICATION/CHANGE:

Part A of the RFP, Item 9 reads: PRICE COMPETITION: Price cannot be an Evaluation Criterion in accordance with PL-92.582 Brooks Act for services that must be performed only by Architects, Engineers or Land Surveyors (A/E or LS) licensed in the State of Alaska, UNLESS the provisions of AS 36.30.270(d) and/or 3 AAC 100.350(8)(H) apply; i.e., unless the services required are repetitious in nature, and the nature and amount of services required are thoroughly defined by measurable and objective standards to reasonably enable firms or persons making proposals to compete with a clear understanding and interpretation of the services required.

- The aforementioned reference to the Brooks Act shall be omitted and provisions of 3 AAC 100.350(8)(H) shall prevail.
- The Criterion in Part C of the RFP, Item 6 remains unchanged.
