CONTRACT PROVISIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

Item #1: PART A, Section 15, Number 15.3 now reads:

Response: 15.3 This agreement will have an initial term of three (3) years with three (3) one (1) year extensions. The amount of funding increase (or the decrease of funds) will be determined based on the anticipated project workload. The total funds are not anticipated to exceed \$7,500,000 for the potential six-year term.

The maximum number of attached pages (each printed side equals one page) for Criteria Responses shall not exceed Ten (10). Attached page limit does not include the four-page Part D - Proposal Form.” Please confirm that the 10 pages limit is for each of the seven evaluation criteria, for no more than 70 pages.

- **Answer #1:** Total number of pages for criteria response is 10, which contains the responses to all criteria. Contractor can adjust length of each evaluation response as needed as long as total pages (entire response) does not exceed 10.
