Addendum 1; (NEW)

Part A: Notice, Bullet 2: A General Conditions and sample contract have been uploaded to the site as stated.

**CLARIFICATION/CHANGE:**

- 1) Part A: Proposal Methods of Payment: Both Firm Fixed Price (FFP) and Other: Time & Expenses (TE) are marked on page 1.

CLARIFICATION/CHANGE: Either method may be used.

- 2) Part C: Item 4, Proposed Project Staff: refers to all personnel acting in responsible charge of engineering to require an Alaska registration. Could you please clarify AIDEA requirements related to this aspect? Do all the engineering positions listed in Section 4 Functions (Marine Engineer, Civil Engineer, Project Manager, Bulk Logistics Specialist) need to be registered in Alaska or would it be acceptable to have one or more designated responsible engineers registered in Alaska with rest of project team being registered in elsewhere?

CLARIFICATION/CHANGE: All Professional Engineers will need to be licensed in the State of Alaska. If other positions listed do not require a professional designation, than registration in the State of Alaska is not required.

- 3) Part D Certification – Foreign Contracting refers to all services to be performed in the US. If the Offeror cannot certify that all work is being performed in the US, the Offeror must contact the Contracts Officer to request a waiver at least 10 days prior to proposal deadline. Please advise if a waiver can be provided out of United States office?

CLARIFICATION/CHANGE: AIDEA is willing to entertain a foreign contracting proposal on a per case basis.

- 4) Could please confirm if the proposal can be submitted **only** by email? The website says submission by email and the RFP document says submission in hard copies.

CLARIFICATION/CHANGE: The preferred choice on submittal is through electronic email. However, you can submit thru registered mail carrier or in person via the drop box at AIDEA.
