The bid documents require acknowledgment individually of all addenda to the drawings and/or specifications. This is a mandatory requirement and any bid received without acknowledgment of receipt of addenda may be classified as not being a responsive bid. If, by virtue of this addendum it is desired to modify a bid already submitted, such modification may be made by email or telefacsimile provided such an email or telefacsimile makes reference to this addendum and is received prior to the opening hour and date specified above.

The RFP Package is hereby clarified or changed as follows:

• <u>Item #1:</u> QUESTION: Is a hard copy of the proposal required?

ANSWER: No. Proposals can be submitted to the email address <u>procurement@aidea.org</u>. Please make sure your cost proposal is saved and attached as a separate file.

• <u>Item #2:</u>

QUESTION: Can we get a copy of the existing emergency plan?

ANSWER: No. The State Energy Security Plan (SESP) does not exist. The State of Alaska Emergency Operations plan is a confidential document and cannot be shared with all potential bidders.

• <u>Item #3:</u>

The exercise portion of the Scope is greyed out. Funding for this project currently expires on June 20, 2023. AEA believes that date can be extended and if/when that occurs, exercises will be requested.

• <u>Item #4:</u>

QUESTION: Section 4.02, Special Formatting Requirements, how can the offeror respond anonymously?

ANSWER: In Section 4.02, Special Formatting Requirements, how can the offeror respond anonymously? That section was left in, in error. Please see "Anonymity" is struck from the section and the submittal forms no longer require it.

SPECIAL FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS

The offeror must ensure that their proposal meets all special formatting requirements identified in this section.

Documents and Text: All attachment documents must be written in the English language, be single sided, and be single spaced with a minimum font size of 10. Pictures or graphics may be used if the offeror feels it is necessary to communicate their information, however, be aware of the below requirements for page limits. **Anonymity:** Some Submittal Forms listed below must not contain any names that can be used to identify who the



offeror is (such as company names, offeror name, company letterhead, personnel names, project names, subconsultant names, manufacturer or supplier names, or product names).

Page Limits: Some Submittal Forms listed below have maximum page limit requirements. Offerors must not exceed the maximum page limits. Note, the page limit applies to the front side of a page only (for example, '1 Page' implies that the offeror can only provide a response on one side of a piece of paper).

ANSWER: AEA would like to know that the offeror has the understanding an ability to plan, organize and implement SESP exercises. However, it is not a required portion of the project at this time, it would be negotiated as a change order.


If the funding date can be extended, AEA will work with the selected contractor to create exercises that would be effective in making sure the SESP is up to date.
